- \$400 buy-in (\$330 prize pool + \$70 administrative fee). Administrative fee includes any and all staffing/dealer fees, and rake.
- Players start with 15,000 in tournament chips.
- Registration will remain open until the start the start of level 9, eliminated players may re-enter until this time at registration.

 All original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter. Players may forfeit or surrender their chips to re-enter.
- Any player who has not taken a hand by the start of the first break may be considered a "no show" and have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- This tournament is scheduled as two-day tournament. The Tournament Director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.
- There will be a 15-minute break approximately every 2 hours of play.
- Day 1 will play until the completion of level 16, unless otherwise announced by the tournament staff.
- Day 2 will resume at 1:00 PM on the following day. There will be a 60-minute dinner break after 10 levels of play on Day 2.
- In Pot-Limit, the ante only counts as part of the pot after the flop.
