- Additional levels will be added as needed.

• \$250 buy-in (\$200 prize pool + \$50 administrative fee) Players start with 12,000 tournament chips.

- \$300 buy-in (\$240 prize pool + \$60 administrative fee) Players start with 24,000 tournament chips. Double Stack
- Administrative fee includes any and all staffing / dealer fees, and rake.

• Registration will remain open until the start the start of level 9, eliminated players may re-enter until this time. All original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter. Players may forfeit or surrender their chips to re-enter.

- A player who has not taken a hand by the start of the first break may be considered a "no show" and have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- This tournament is scheduled as one-day tournament\*. The Tournament Director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.
- There will be a 15-minute break approximately every 2 hours of play and a 60-minute dinner break after 6 hours of play.
- "Seniors" tournaments are open to all players 50 years of age or older.

\*Day 2 (if necessary) will resume at 1:00 PM on the following day.
